Avian Expeditioners will take your campers' love of birds to the next level. Each camper will receive their very own pair of Vortex binoculars to take home, and will use their binoculars all week to get a close-up look at some of the amazing birds of Western New York.



Campers will learn how to be 21st Century Birders by using technology like eBird and Merlin to participate in community science programs and keep track of the birds they identify.

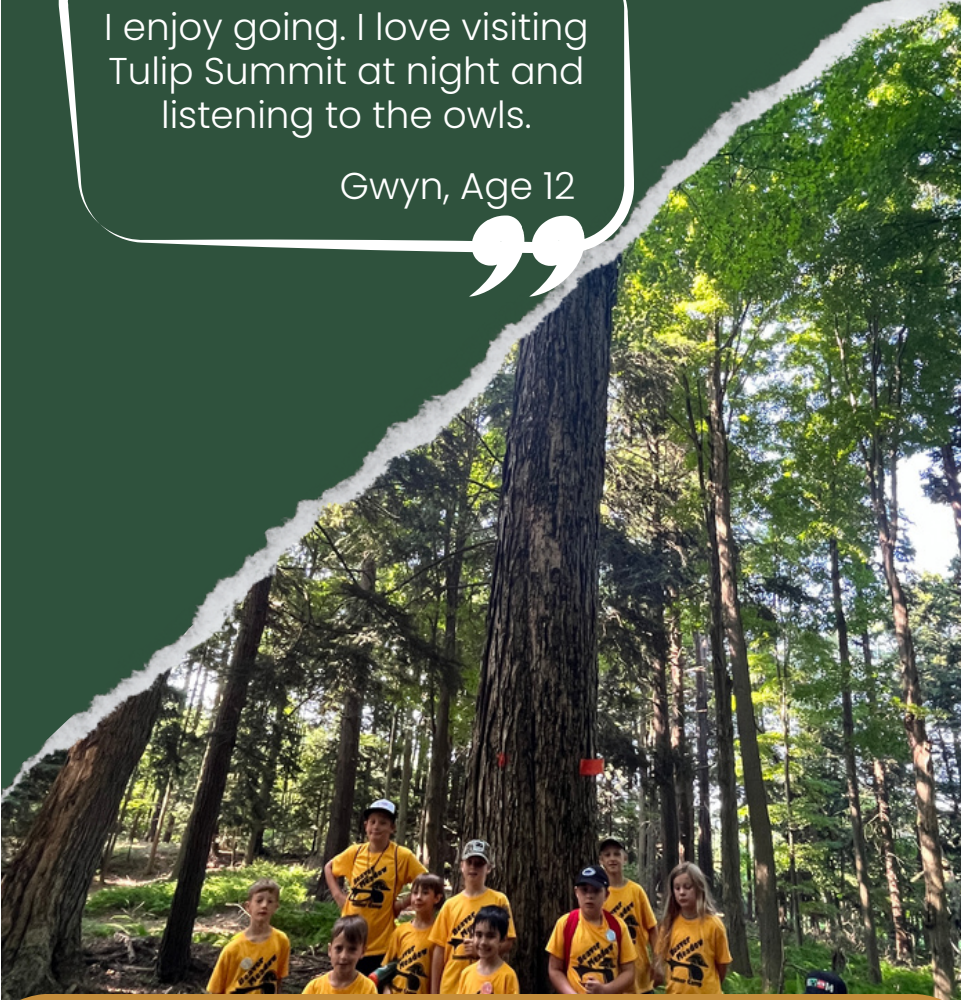
