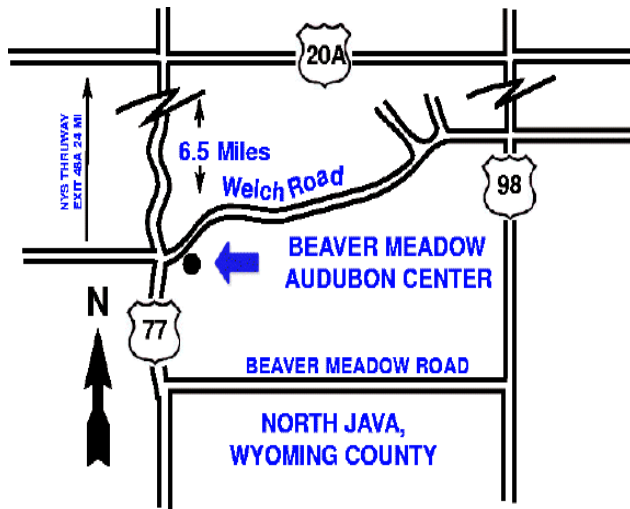


How to get to Beaver Meadow

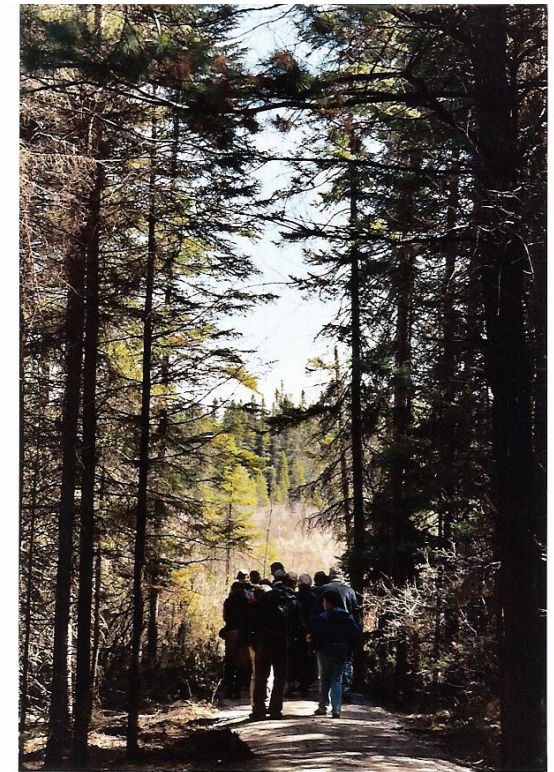

Discover the way things used to be. Nature hikes, crafts, home-made ice cream, food, demonstrations and much more.

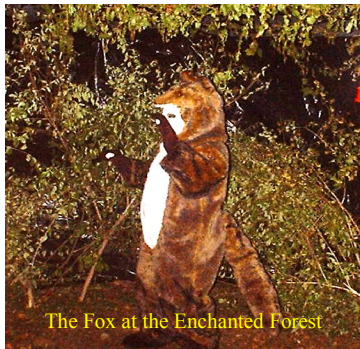


Flintknapping at the Home-

Take an evening walk through the woods at Beaver Meadow to meet some of the creatures (costumed characters) that live here. An exciting time for young and old.

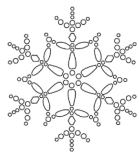


The Fox at the Enchanted Forest

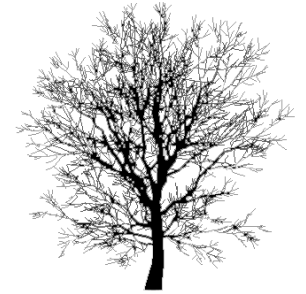
